

Malvern Brickfest Health rules and Guidelines

- 1. Cooking teams may use any type of fuel desired. If Charcoal is supplied, all other fuels have to be supplied by the cooking teams.**
- 2. Teams are to provide ice chests for rib storage if needed. Brickfest will
Have ice for sale if needed.**
- 3. No other meat is to be present other than the meat supplied to each team from the Malvern Brickfest.**
- 4. All meat and other foods are to be handled in a sanitary manner. Plastic gloves will be provided and are to be used in handling the foods at all times when needed.**
- 5. Grills will be inspected for cleanliness before cooking. Unclean grills will be rejected.**
- 6. The cooking teams provide all of the seasonings and “secret ingredients”.**
- 7. Cooking teams are responsible for their own tables and chairs and /tents that they might need.**
- 8. Some type of fire extinguishing device should be readily available to each cooker.**
- 9. Baby Back ribs may not be removed from your numbered cooking area. Any violation of this will result in immediate team disqualification.**
- 10. All ribs remain the property of the Malvern Brickfest Festival. Teams are expected to account for all Ribs issued, either by turning in their ticket stubs or cooked ribs. We realize that meat is occasionally lost in the cooking process, we understand this and make allowances where necessary.**
